UKRAINE UPDATE

NASHI wishes to inform and update you on your girls. They are still in Poland except for our 2 girls who are taking post-secondary classes – one in university and one at a technical school and both are back in Ukraine. In 2025, we and they are hoping they will be able to return to Ukraine depending on the crisis. The Maple Leaf House is in western Ukraine – close to the Polish border where it is relatively peaceful. However, should our director feel it is still unsafe they will continue their stay in Poland.



Ukraine is a hotspot for human trafficking. Poverty and the war make women and girls especially vulnerable to sex trafficking. Highly developed criminal networks exploit Ukraine's high level of poverty and corruption rendering Ukrainians one of the largest groups of foreign trafficking victims in Europe. NASHI, WITH THE HELP OF OUR DONORS AND VOLUNTEERS are providing our girls with a safe loving environment.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND PORNOGRAPHY

Human trafficking is one of the greatest challenges of this century around the world. NASHI knows the extent of trafficking locally and globally. NASHI would like to thank all of you for being part of our fight against human trafficking. We are a small organization but with your help we have made an impact locally and globally. - a complex crime hard to measure.
- 45 million people are enslaved in the world.
- Girls as young as 5 years old are taken into sex trafficking
- Making \$200 billion dollars per year

Facts

- By age twelve 90% of boys have watched porn
- Porn embodies sexual exploitation and teaches violence
- Pornography, prostitution and trafficking are inter-related
- Porn is accessible, anonymous, acceptable, aggressive and addictive
